

**01. ABOUT ORGANIZATION: -**

Ganeswar Club popularly known as **-GC-** is a grass root level organization committed to all-round development of society with special focus on village community. A group of volunteers got together during 15th August 1975 observing National Independence Day, this was followed by keeping alive different occasions for a common cause to lift social, educational and economic situation of community. Particularly those people living below poverty line and in social segregation. The concept for complete approach was gradually developed by the united efforts of the youths. Basing on these attitudes of youth Mr. Ganeswar of village Bankatia contributed a piece of land at the middle place of his village for the shed of this noble purpose. So all the people of that time decided to name it as **“Ganeswar Club”** and it got its legal entity in 19th September 1980. After registration the organization came in with Nehru Yuba Kendra of the District to organize youth activities. Gradually it contacted OREDA, BBSR for smokeless Chula activity and NEAC programs of the ministry of Forests, Environment, Govt. of India. In the year 1987 the organization accorded the FC registration to get financial support from abroad. Then the shape of socio-development was gradually facilitated through activities by getting support from government and international agencies. At the first instance it was support by EZE through Gandhi Peace Center where the work strategy geared towards Gandhi an approach of rebuilding socio-education fabric of the community. Afterwards we were getting support from TDH, CWS, HIVOS and GOVT. of India. Learning from the past experiences and changing in to the present pattern of philosophy in interacts with the original section of the society for village self sufficiency and self management which is the real aim of forming Gram Swaraj. It always establishes its relationship with poor and marginal for their own progress on the basis of mutual co-operation, participation and consolidation and of people's knowledge sustainable development.

- Dissemination of Information be face the people.
- Organizing the people on the basis of their felt need.
- Involving people through various skill training and to improve their standard of living through income generation program.
- Providing support services for the sustain ability of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry.
- Making the people to realize their stand in the society as a human being irrespective Caste, creed and sex.
- Empowering the women to strengthen their stand in the society.
- Availing the scope of any government and non-government program for the Development of society.

03. METHODOLOGY: -

In order to realize the objectives of the association and in course of ensuring rights and justice for people and the down trodden these methods are employed.

- Counseling of both the parties for management and reconciliation, if possible.

- Environmental awareness programs.
- Encouraging group formation for mutual and community assistance in the rural areas.

05. STRUCTURE AND MANAGEMENT:-

The governing body is the eleven member apex body in which there are five female members and six male members. It functions as the primary policy making body of the organization. 45 members are functioning in different capacities. For guide and smooth administration a core committee is function, in which there are five members. Our secretary and program co-coordinator are the member of the governing body those who keep liaison with staff and management. The women co-coordinator is especially responsible for women's wing as we have more emphasis to women wings.

The organization has own office building with consist of office room, staff room, small training hall, weaving unit room & Toilet. The office also provides motorcycle, bicycle and computer for better mobility of staff.

GC started its work initially in 2nos. Gram Panchayata which was later extended to the suburbs and then further extended in to all sub-divisions of the district. More than 60 villages with SC/ST and Dalit communities spread over 7 G.P.s are the major area where intensive activities are undertaken. Most of the people of the area belong to most backward communities of SC, ST & Dalit like Harijana, Juanga, Sabara, Kandha, Patua & Ganda. As per tradition the families follow nuclear mode. Soon after marriage they get separated. Economically people are very poor and backward. They face the problem of minimum food, health, education, clothing etc. Due to unemployment women having no job of their own do face socio-nutritional hazards. In such a critical socio-economic scene, GC extends its helping hand to each individual victim and tries to wipe out the tears and to alleviate the agony.

06. A MOMENTARY VIEW ON WORK OF GC:-

GANESWAR CLUB as a leading Organization in Dhenkanal District, Orissa having 30 years experience in different activities prospective now only can be able to establish a platform where the victims of people started breaking their silence, express their sufferings and raise their voice against exploitation. The following are some past achievements of the Organization:

- **100nos.** SHG with **30nos.** People Organization has been formed and strengthens in order to work for the development of their community.
- GC promoting the women (**SC/ST&DALITS as well as VICTIMIZED women of violence**) by providing various skill development training with free of cost on tailoring, Pampered, pickles, weaving, leaf cup & plate, Wool knitting etc.
- Creation of awareness among **350 villages** (RURAL) through street play to eradicate various social stigmas like illiteracy, alcoholism, dowry torture, environment pollution, health, gender, child labor, sexual harassment and anti poverty programs etc.
- 20nos. youth trained by GC on constructed **120** such ovens.
- **50,000** seedlings raised in Buhalipal village with people cooperation and planted on a **50-acre** patch of land taken on lease from the government to develop community assets.
- GC constructed **4nos. L.I. point, 20nos. Dug well, 6nos. water reservoir tank, 2nos. cross bond, 15nos. compost peat, 500nos. cur bar and 500-acres land reclamation** for the people in agriculture purpose.
- GC was continuing **24nos.** education center for SC/ST children in different hamlet.
- GC continuing a public library services belonging **7500nos.** books for youth and others.



- GC organized women and people conference for **8 times**.
- GC constructed **1200nos.** Individual Household Latrine for community.
- GC organized to **197nos.** women for tubectomy operation.
- GC organized **10times** exposure trip to community for developed in various activities.
- GC conducted **RCH-II** activities in 4nos. Gram Panchayata.

We enrol those children who were not in AWC in their age. We check the attendance in AWC to identify the absent student and long absent student as well as the D.O. after the identification they went to meet them to know about the real cause for which she/he was absent. Then meet their family member to know real reason and trying to convince them.

(IV) GENERAL ACTIVITIES:

a. Farm School Activities by ATMA:

One program has implemented by Ganeswar Club, Bankatia for increasing rice productivity in the block by introducing SRI method of rice cultivation. Ganeswar Club, Bankatia was organized SRI program firm school under ATMA in village **Lahada** of Hindol block through his staff.

b. Seed treatment campaign:

With getting support from District agriculture office, Dhenkanal, we have organized seed treatment campaign program in 20nos villages.

c. BGREI on paddy cultivation:

With getting support from District agriculture office, Dhenkanal, we have organized the awareness program on line transplanting of paddy in 2nos. Gram Panchayata. Total 500 hectors covered in different Gram Panchayata.

d. Formation of people Organization & Women Organization:

In our area, we have formed 55 nos. of People's organization like **Gandhi gram Sangathan** and 60nos. of **Kasturuba Mahila Samgathan** for male and female members. In each month we are conducting a meeting with our staff and community. It will give a base for catch out the problem of community as well as clarified. Unit is the most essential for strengthen the organization. So we have planned different training program for these community to growth their capacity building.

e. Revolving support to beneficiaries:

Low standard of living is the cause of illiteracy and poverty is the main reason of under development. To improve the living status GANESWAR CLUB extended its support to poor family. It seems that the beneficiaries are now able to get a part time income for them. In this manner we have supported 25nos. beneficiaries for income generation program at Alusingh Paikasahi, Chilataila, Basantia, Menakasahi, Badagola and Illirisinga. It is a better program for community. A time is fixed for return these amounts from them, and then it will be given revolved.

f. Community support to people organization & women organization:



During this year we have supported 15nos. people organization and 14nos. women organization to this community support on molasses, kitchen garden & rice processing program. In this manner they are raising their community funds.

g. Paribesa Osha (Awareness campaign on environment program):

Environmental preservation and awareness has been undertaken regularly by GC in the villages, during this Year, we have conducted this program on dt.27.10.2018 at the shrine of goddess of **Sikshyabauti** near village Kunua. Approximately 69nos.women are joined this program in different Gram Panchayata. All that is championed is unfolding the spiritual relation we have with the trees so that we feel preserving the environment on that day the participants water the trees and go for Plantation during rainy season. Mr. Rama Chandra Sahu, Science teacher of kalingapal high school was joined as chief guest said this program.

h. Observation of Laxmipuja and Drama (Annual Function):-

Like every year this year we also organized a Laxmipuja in our premises. On this occasion we also celebrated a cultural activity. Our Laxmipuja was held on dt.07.10.18 to dt.13.10.18. This program was very attractive due to partly social issues involved.

i. Eye check up camp:

2nos eye check up camp was organized by GC in 2 phases with the collaboration of Kalinga eye hospital, Dhenkanal. Total 57nos are identified for **cathartic operation. It is a focus activity in our area where those peoples were getting facilities in free of cost.**
