Ganeswar Club is known as **GC**. It is a volunteer organization. A group of local youths were together on the occasion of **NATIONAL YOUTH DAY**, They are dedicated and Give their effort to change the people life style who're lived in the remote areas of Hindol Block, Dhenkanal district. To notice the effort of Youths **Mr. Ganeswar Mishra** had donated a piece of land to them. So all the Youth are decided to create a Club and that's known as "**Ganeswar Club**". After that it got its legal entity in 19th September 1980. After registered it connected with **Nehru Yuba Kendra** to do youth activities. For more improved it was gradually contacted OREDA, BBSR (Smokeless Chula activity) and also joined NEAC (National Environment Awareness campaign) programs of the ministry of Environment Forests, Govt. of India. In 1987 the organization registered with FCRA to get financial assistance from abroad. It was the first time to get ZEE support from Gandhi Peace Centre for engaging in Socio economic activities. After that GC received support from TDH (Terre des hommes), CWS, HIVOS and GOVT. Through this opportunity, GC is Involved in the overall development of poor people and has reached the limit of maturity today. After working for 30,000 families in Hindol Block, GC has been able to extend its support to districts like Cuttack.
